

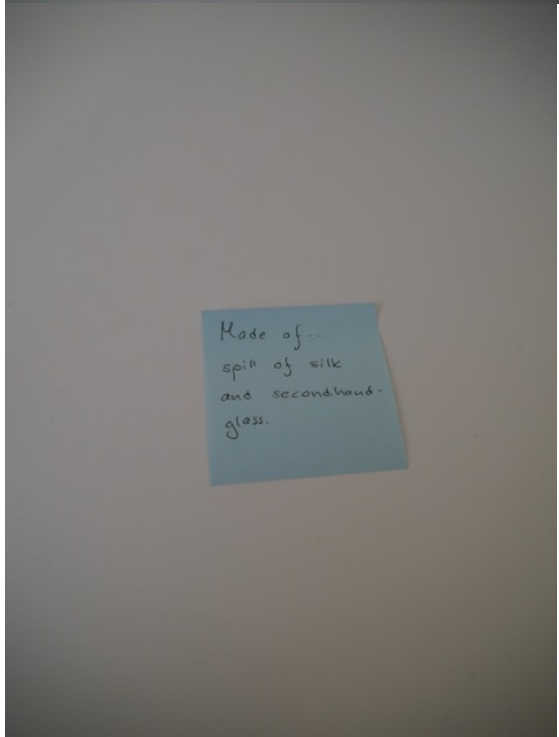
## **Museum of Repair**

a temporary museum that collects the repaired, instead of searching for the prepared

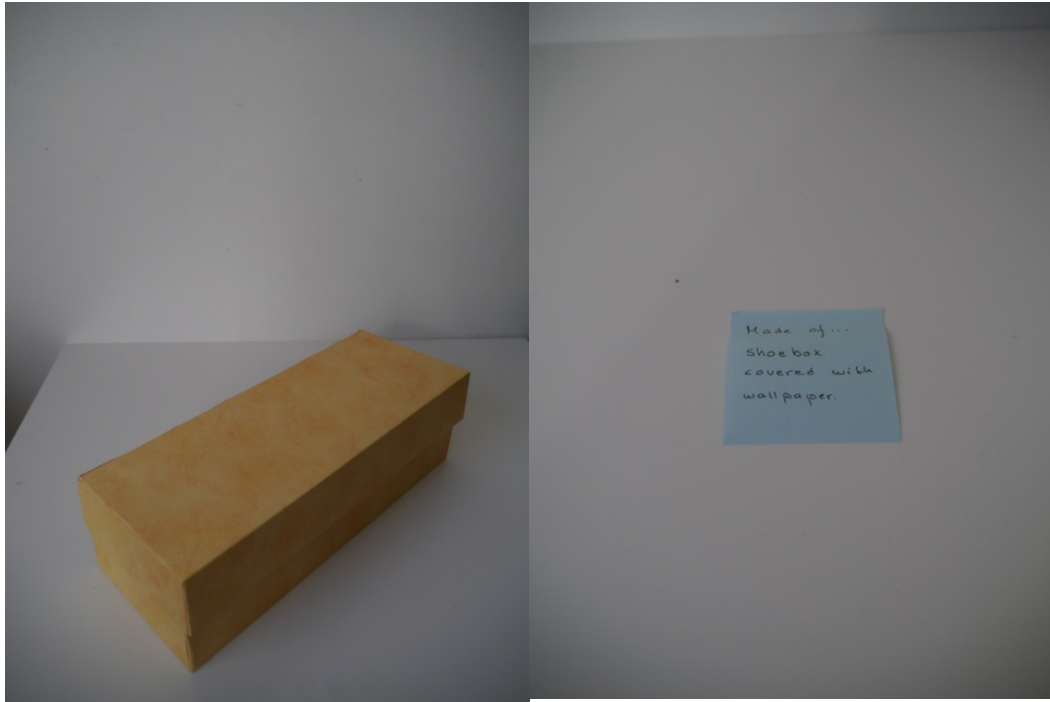

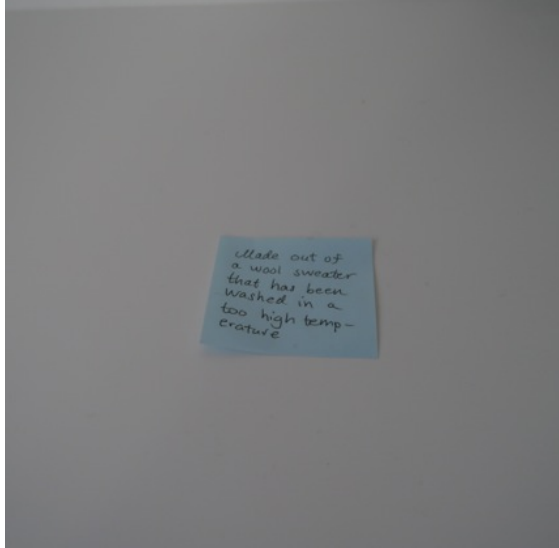


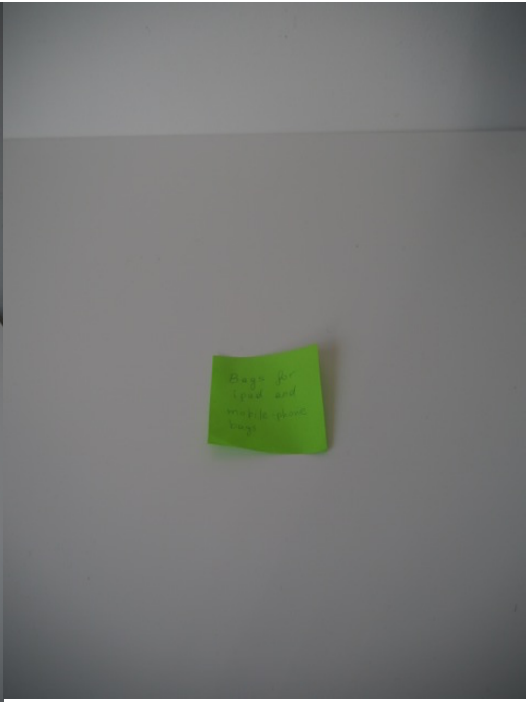
